Please make sure that all items are furnished on the list below in order for the scholarship committee to have make an informed decision about the applicant.

- A. Written essay outlining your career goals, family situation and financial need, and why you are applying for this scholarship
- B. Document school and community honors and activities
- C. Three letters of reference
- D. Your most recent academic transcript from school

**Note: The scholarship committee will not consider this application if information is missing or incomplete.**

To be considered by the Board of Directors, this completed application must be returned to the Executive Secretary at Empire Electric no later than February 15 of the current year.
